The Season After Pentecost

MAY 16 - NOVEMBER 26

(Leader) O Lord, open our lips.

(People) And our mouth shall proclaim your praise. Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen. Alleluia!

The earth is the Lord's for me made it: *Come let us adore him.*

JUBILATE (Psalm 100)

Be joyful in the Lord, all you lands; serve the Lord with gladness and come before his presence with a song. *Know this: The Lord himself is God; he himself has made us, and we are his; we are his people and the sheep of his pasture.*

Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise; give thanks to him and call upon his Name. For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his faithfulness endures from age to age.

<u>THE PSALM OR PSALMS APPOINTED</u> At the end of the Psalms is said:

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.

The Lessons

Lessons from the Old Testament and New Testament, as appointed, are read. At the end of the lessons is said:

The Word of the Lord. *Thanks be to God.*

THE SECOND SONG OF ISAIAH (Isaiah 55:6-11)

(Leader) Seek the Lord while he wills to be found; call upon him when he draws near. (People) Let the wicked forsake their ways and the evil ones their thoughts; Let them turn to the Lord, and he will have compassion, and to our God, for he will richly pardon.

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor your ways my ways, says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

For as rain and snow fall from the heavens and return not again, but water the earth, Bringing forth life and giving growth, seed for sowing and bread for eating, So is my word that goes forth from my mouth; it will not return to me empty; It will accomplish that which I have purposed, and prosper in that for which I sent it. Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.

The Apostles' Creed

Christian, what do you believe? I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ His only Son our Lord;

The holy catholic Church; The communion of saints; The forgiveness of sins; The resurrection of the body; And the life everlasting. Amen.

Day by day we bless you; We praise your name for ever.

Lord, keep us from all sin today; *Have mercy upon us, Lord, have mercy.*

Lord, show us your love and mercy; *For we put our trust in you.*

In you, Lord, is our hope; And we shall never hope in vain.

O God, the author of peace and lover of concord, to know you is eternal life and to serve you is perfect freedom: Defend us, your humble servants, in all assaults of our enemies; that we, surely trusting in your defense, may not fear the power of any adversaries; through the might of Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

CONFESSION OF SIN

(Leader) Dear friends in Christ, here in the presence of Almighty God, let us kneel in silence, and with penitent and obedient hearts confess our sins, that we may obtain forgiveness by his infinite goodness and mercy. (People) Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.

(PAUSE FOR A TIME OF SILENT CONFESSION)

May the Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us all our sins through our Lord Jesus Christ, strengthen us in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep us in eternal life. Amen.

O GRACIOUS LIGHT (Phos hilaron)

O gracious light, pure brightness of the everliving Father in heaven, O Jesus Christ, holy and blessed!

Now as we come to the setting of the sun, and our eyes behold the vesper light, we sing your praises, O God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

You are worthy at all times to be praised by happy voices, O Son of God, O Giver of Life, and to be glorified through all the worlds.
