The Lord answered beyond our hopes and dreams. It brings to mind Ephesians 3:20, "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us." On 12/22/18 I met with a Diplomat from the Rwandan Ambassador to the UN. He also really liked the film and said that he would like for it to be shown at the UN General Assembly Commemoration Ceremony of the genocide this April. So, it looks like Unforgivable could be shown at the UN in NYC and in DC for the 25th Anniversary. It still needs to be approved by the committee, but its looking good!
